


Reading Schemes and Books

In Year 6, children continue to use the <u>Accelerated Reader</u> scheme that they have been using for the past few years.

In order to change reading books, due to the new measures in school, we ask for them to be brought in every Friday and they will get a new reading book every Monday. They need to record their reading in their new reading records and bring them in with their books. It would be great if you could listen to your child reading multiple times during the week. This will allow them to build reading fluency and discuss any tricky words that they found when reading.

Focus on the following when reading-

- Slow reading speed down, taking note of punctuation \Rightarrow
- Tracking the sentence with a finger to avoid missing lines out \Rightarrow
- Re-reading a sentence if it didn't make sense \Rightarrow
- Asking for help with any words they don't understand the meaning of \Rightarrow





Homework is given out every FRIDAY and is to be brought in the following FRIDAY. Children will receive—maths and SPAG. We will also begin sending reading homework in the coming weeks. Reading comprehension homework is set every other week. There will be time on a Friday for children to ask about any questions they found tricky.
