Learning Mentor additional 3 hours per week (KS) £596

The learning mentor will support pupils with vulnerabilities which could impact on learning.

IRIS connect system £5422.50

Evidence shows that high quality teaching and learning is the most effective method of maximising pupil progress. We invest heavily in professional learning which will then impact on progress for all pupils. This camera system supports teachers to develop their way of teaching and meeting the needs of all pupils.

Funding residential visits £420

We fund residential visits for pupils in receipt of pupil premium

CPOMS safeguarding system: £895

We have an online safeguarding recording and alert system which ensures that the needs of all pupils are met holistically.

Alphasmart computers £982

Pupils can use these computers to be supported in developing communication skills and this will impact upon learning.
